Fluid Waste Disposal

PIR has containers throughout the paddock for waste oil and antifreeze.

Power

Available but not guaranteed.

RV overnights

Allowed in paddock at no charge.

Load out

Rigs and Haulers may stay overnight Sunday night if they move to the Broad acre field (outside the front gate).

Golf Cart Rentals

Golf carts can be rented through J & S Golf Carts at 503-647-1984.

Scooters/Pit bikes

Motorcycle AND Moped Helmet Law Chapter 814.269 Must wear a motorcycle helmet that is DOT- compliant. Only exception is 814.290 when operating a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in contact with the ground at speeds of less than 15 mph.

Sound Limit/Policy

Portland has a sound limit variance that allows 112db. It will be monitored on driver's left exiting turn 12. One reading of 112 will cause the driver to be black flagged and he/she will have one attempt to get under 112. If unsuccessful, you will be black flagged again and not allowed to return. Race engines may not be started prior to 8:00 a.m. and absolutely no engine revving prior to 8:30 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS ALLOWED without express written permission from PIR management. This policy is strictly enforced.

Venue Speed Limit

The speed limit on PIR's 278 acres is 15 mph. Violation may lead to expulsion from the facility.

Alcohol

It is a violation of Portland City Law to bring alcohol in to the PIR venue. Alcohol may ONLY be purchased from the licensed PIR contracted food and service vendor, Spectra, on-site.

Smoking

PIR is a smoke free environment.

Pets

Pets are allowed, but they must be on a leash at all times and owners must pick up after them.
