If the license does not show medical then you must have the PVGP Medical Form completed by a physician within the last 2 years and submitted with your entry. Anyone competitor over the age of 60 is strongly encouraged to have an annual physical and EKG/ECG Vehicle Preparation: Vehicles must meet the preparation specifications of the vintage race club you are entering under. It is therefore the responsibility of each competitor to research the proper period specification for his car, and to present it as such. The PVGPA will accept the Rules & Regulations of your organization with the below exceptions. Body: The body configuration should be as raced "in period". All body parts must be of the same material and design as those supplied by the manufacturer as standard or optional. Wheels: Wheel diameter must be as originally fitted. Engine: The correct engine displacement. Engines must be of the original type; size and design as originally fitted by the manufacturer and be in the correct location. Tires: Beginning in 2021 the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix has adopted the tire rules and regulations of the VRG – see attached tire sheet. Slicks: The PVGP and the VRG do not allow slicks under any circumstances. This is a longstanding rule, and slicks were not allowed in 2018 for the PVGP Kastner Cup.

Registration Fees:

- Entry Fees Early (before May 21): \$545 Regular \$595 Late: (after July 1) \$645
- Thursday, July 14 Test & Tune on full track at PIRC: \$250 (no half-day available)
- 2nd or 3rd Car/Same Driver or Same Car/Same Driver -2 Groups: \$200
- Additional Crew (driver and 2 crew are included with entry) \$30 Each Includes dinner Saturday
- Kastner Cup: Saturday Kastner Cup Race and Sunday Reunion Race: \$50 (Note this funding goes to the PVGP to offset their cost including the Kastner Cup tent)
- Garage Rental: \$350

Paddock Location:The Kastner Cup paddock location are Lots 4B and 4C. The Kastner Cup tent will be installed in
the adjacent grass area.

Race Groups: Triumphs will race within their assigned race groups throughout the weekend with the 30-minute Kastner Cup feature race on Saturday afternoon and the 20-minute Kastner Reunion Race on Sunday morning. Be sure to check the next page for the race groups. TR8's will likely be assigned to the Group Pounders/Vintage Large Bore group.

Race Groups (text from <u>PVGP</u> site):

- <u>Vintage Small-Bore & Formula Vee</u>: Vintage eligible small-bore production cars up to 1974. Includes Mini Cooper, Triumph, Turner, Austin-Healey Sprite, MG Midget and MG TD.
- <u>Vintage Medium-Bore</u>: Vintage eligible medium-bore production and special cars up to 1974. A wide variety of popular sports cars including BMW 2002, Datsun 510, Elva Courier, Triumph GT6, MGB, Alfa Romeo, Lotus Europa and Elan.
- <u>Ground Pounders (two classes)</u>:
 - <u>Vintage Large-Bore</u>: Production and special cars from 2.0 to 3.0L. Eligible cars from 1976 and earlier (later cars must be approved). Big time excitement with Austin Healey 100, Chevy Corvair, Porsche 911 and Datsun 240Z
 - <u>Ground Pounders</u>: Large displacement production and special cars over 3.0L. Eligible cars up to 1976 (later cars must be approved). Ground pounding racing like GT40, Corvette, Camaro, Sunbeam Tiger, Jaguar and Ferrari.

Kastner Cup Merchandise:

Racers and crew will be able to <u>purchase</u> a limited number of tee shirts, posters and other Kastner Cup merchandise at the Kastner Cup tent on Friday during the British Sportscar Hall of Fame reception. <u>FOT will not charge a separate fee</u> <u>for this event</u>, so we can't provide free merchandise. After Friday, sales of all items will be open to public, so buy your items early!

Vintage Racer Group Tire Rules Updated: 1/6/2020

Tires: Beginning in 2021 the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix has adopted the tire rules and regulations of the VRG:

- Sizing is based on existing rules and regulations for individual car classification.
- Tread must extend across the tire (no DOT slicks with only circumferential grooves).
- Minimum 2/32nds of measurable tread.
- Minimum UTQG of 100 AAA.
- Minimum speed rating of H.

Some examples of acceptable tires:

- Avon ACB10
- Goodyear Blue Streak
- Hoosier Street TD & Speedster
- Toyo RA1, R888- R888R, R1R

Some examples of non-acceptable tires: Slicks or any of the following tires:

- Avon Tech RA
- BFG G -Force R1
- Goodyear GS/CS/RS
- Hankook Z214
- Hoosier DOT Radial, (A6 or R6)
- Kumho V710
- Toyo RR
- or any other "street slick" type DOT tire.

NON-DOT Racing Tires:

The non-DOT treaded racing tires listed below are approved for VRG competition:

- Avon: ACB9, CR6ZZ, A29, H-003 and H-009
- Goodyear: BlueStreaks, Vintage Sports Car Specials, G12 and G12A
- Hoosier: Vintage TD, Street TD, Speedster, TDR, TDS, R35B, and VFF
- Dunlop: L-series, M-series, CR65, and CR82

Any non-DOT racing tire that is not listed above, is not approved for VRG competition.


