# ELVF (Elkhart Lake Vintage Festival) held in Elkhart Lake, WI & Road America Race Track (revised 2.5.18)

This Special 60<sup>th</sup> Sprite Anniversary is expected to be the largest gathering of Street and combined Vintage Race Cars in the United States. Why can we say that, well in the past 6 years VSCDA Sprite Midget Series has consistently had 15 or more Spridget Racing wheel to wheel racing with up to 23 Spridgets at one event. Knowing this is a special event we think 50 plus Spridgets Racing in additions to all those Street Spridgets that supports Donald and Geoffrey Healey's vision of creating a low price good handling Sports Car is not understated! We already have input from all US Coasts and Canada wanting to attend this event. This event, is more than a Vintage Race or Car Show in fact it is both including a Concours of Special Spridgets in the Historic Elkhart Lake where Sports Car Racing started. This weekend is very busy. Racing Spridget will have many options covered that you can attend through your VSCDA Race Registration. Street Spridgets will not be allowed into the Road America Paddock without a Paddock Pass. If you purchase an advance Paddock Pass through Stan Mason by August 1, 2018 you will get a discount and have access to special paddock parking across from Sprite Racing Paddock and also be included in the open lap for street cars prior to the 60<sup>th</sup> Sprite Reunion Race. You will also have several other options on form below. The following is highlight of events for this weekend with preliminary agenda, Street Spridget Forms and abbreviated Map of events and location below:

- Special Historic Sprites and Midgets with international racing history Saturday Evening, displayed at the GOG Concours (Gather On the Green) in front of the Osthoff Resort along with other Special Street Spridgets.
- Road America Spridget Racing Paddock Compound with special registered Street Spridgets allowed in Exclusive Spridget Paddock directly across from Spridget Race Paddock.
- Race Spridget Car Show Friday night by popular vote with Past SCCA racer recognition, in addition with Cape Of Good Hope Portable Bar toasting, prior to Race Car and Crew "Welcome to ELVF Party" dinner
- Street Spridget Car Show Saturday morning by popular vote at Exclusive Spridget Paddock
- Race and Street Spridgets also can join in the Historic Elkhart Lake Street Race Course Reenactment Saturday (free to Race Entrant additional cost for Street Spridgets, be part of US Sports Car Racing's beginning). You start the tour at Road America and end up downtown

- Elkhart Lake to display your car near the iconic Historic Siebken's Bar where many a Race Car Driver and Crew have enjoyed a pint
- 60<sup>th</sup> Sprite Banquet with Road America Magazine's Peter Egan who has entertained us with his Sports Car Column for years and started Sports Car Racing in a Bug Eye Sprite will be held Saturday Night.
- 60<sup>th</sup> Sprite Midget Race with 1 Lap Street Sprite prior to race Sunday.
- Touring (during lunch) Saturday free for Race Cars (must have signed touring waiver for other drivers or passengers). Street Cars must pay per instructions below.
- Race Spridgets will be in VSCDA's Group 2 with the exception of Sunday afternoon Cup Races, which will be based on your lap times only not by group. Most of us will qualify for the Kimberly Cup >3 minute ET with faster Spridgets in the Sheldon Cup <3 minute ET You must go to registration and inform them of what cup race you will be in before 4:30 Saturday if you want to race in these Cup Races.</li>
- The Special Street Reunion Package has reduced pricing if you fill out forms, sign waiver and forward check by August 1, 2018 to Stan Mason.
- Race registration covers many of these events with the exception of GOG, which requires separate registration and acceptance.
- Racers are encouraged to bring additional race gas with 8 race sessions and reenactment.

## **Touring Instructions**

Drive the Road America racecourse in your vintage or modern car in company with similar vehicles (NO SUVs, Trucks or Vans). Passengers are allowed. Registration must be completed at least 1 hour prior to the Touring session. All street cars must proceed to the touring paddock for the mandatory drivers meeting and to receive your touring sticker. Seat belts and a valid U.S. issued driver's license are required. See the event schedule & listen for announcements for exact times. The pace car and starter will be used to control touring sessions. You may not pass the pace car unless waved or pointed by the driver. Top speed is 55 M.P.H. No passing is allowed except on the straights. The pass should be completed before the braking zone markers. Cars should proceed single file through all turns.

Passengers in Touring Cars - No child may be held as a "babe in arms" nor be allowed to ride in a removable child's car seat during touring. The child must be large enough to see over the dashboard or out the side of the touring car and be safely secured by the touring car's seat belts. If you pick up a passenger on grid; when returning to the track, you must stay track right. Do not cross the blend line. Once the blend line stops move safely on to the proper line

#### RACE CAR TOURING:

#### Enter from the grid

If a young adult is to tour in a racecar, all of the above must be met. The young adult must fit securely in the competition harness. In addition, the young adult should be wearing ear protection and a **proper fitting**,full-face shield helmet. If you pick up a passenger on grid; when returning to the track, you must stay track right. Do not cross the blend line. Once the blend line stops move safely on to the proper line.

Registration – All touring entrants must register at VSCDA registration. (Gate 6) You must complete the entry form, sign the VSCDA waiver and pay the fee. If you have pre-registered you must still sign the waiver and get your wristband. Racecars registered for Elkhart Lake Vintage Festival XXXIII® are FREE but the driver and passenger must have signed a VSCDA waiver and be wearing a VSCDA wrist band.

Touring Instructions — Listen for the track announcer regarding staging/grid prior to the touring sessions. Touring sessions will stage south of the VIP Tower, before Turn 1. Attend the Mandatory Touring Driver's Meeting in the Touring Paddock. See the schedule for time. Touring cars will enter the racetrack upon instructions from the OFFICIAL and will exit the track at the same location. If you choose to end your touring session before the checkered flag, exit through the paddock. Touring ends when the checkered flag is displayed at the bridge. All cars will then proceed at a MUCH reduced speed, in single file to exit.

#### **Guidelines for Touring Safety**

VSCDA is not responsible for the mechanical or electrical condition of your vehicle. By signing the entry form you acknowledge that it is 100% your responsibility that your vehicle is capable of operating safely at normal interstate highway speeds. We recommend you check the following:

At a minimum the following items should be attended to prior to participating in a touring session:

- Hub caps must be removed
- Lug nuts must be tight
- Brake lights must be operational
- Brake fluid levels should be adequate

- Engine, hoses and seat belts inspected
- 6. Soft tops totally secured (up or down)
- All body panels secured
- Do not over fill gas tank

#### **Touring Entry Saturday and/or Sunday** NO SUVs, Trucks or Vans

- Registered race cars are FREE but the driver and passenger must have signed a VSCDA waiver and be wearing a VSCDA wrist band. This is not a race. All rules must be followed!
- All persons driving street cars must sign a VSCDA Waiver, complete entry form, pay fee and get a touring wrist band.
- All passengers must sign a VSCDA waiver and get a touring wrist band; Parents must sign for minor
- Only the person wearing the Driver's wrist band may drive. No one will be allowed out on the track without a touring wrist band.
- After registration, all street cars must proceed to the touring paddock for MANDATORY drivers meeting least 1 hour prior to the touring session
